

Field Review of New Geologic Mapping

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Assemble at the community dump site just south of State Highway 24, about 1/3 mile west of the Torrey-Teasdale Road at 8:00 a.m.; depart at 8:15 a.m. For questions, or in case of inclement weather and possible trip cancellation, please contact Tyler Huth or Brennan Young (508-577-7271 or 801-550-7826). No RSVP required, but please wear appropriate field clothing and come prepared for a morning-long hike.

The field review will start with a 2 mile hike through Moenkopi, Chinle, Wingate, Kayenta, Navajo, Temple Cap, and basal Carmel strata, and also look at and discuss the age and formation of the Teasdale Bench, one of several alluvial deposits that record incision of the Fremont River drainage system. Optional stops include the Cockscomb and a view of the Teasdale fault.
